If you make a mistake, ask for a new ballot.</p>	<p><b>For Economic Development Program Renewal City of Ravenna, Nebraska</b></p> <p><b>Proposition 1:</b></p> <p>A majority vote in favor of this Proposition for continuation of the Economic Development Program and a majority of the votes in favor of the local option sales tax in Proposition 2 are necessary to renew the Economic Development Program. If a majority of those voting on the issue in either Proposition 1 or Proposition 2 vote against the question, the City of Ravenna shall not renew the Economic Development Program.</p> <p>"Shall the City of Ravenna continue an Economic Development Program as described here by annually appropriating revenue collected from a one-half percent (.5%) local option sales tax approved by the voters for a period of 15 years?"</p> <p><input type="radio"/> YES (for continuing the Economic Development Program)</p> <p><input type="radio"/> NO (against continuing the Economic Development Program)</p>	<p><b>For Continuing the Tax for Economic Development Program City of Ravenna, Nebraska</b></p> <p><b>Proposition 2:</b></p> <p>A majority vote in favor of the following proposition would continue a .5% (½ cent) sales tax that is ongoing upon transactions within the city which are subject to sales tax. This tax would continue for an additional 15 years until April 1, 2042. The proceeds from this tax can only be used for the Economic Development Program. A majority of those voting on the issue in Proposition 2 and the previous issue in Proposition 1 must vote in favor of both propositions in order for the Economic Development Program to be continued by the City. If a majority of those voting on the issue in either Proposition 1 or Proposition 2 vote against the question, the City of Ravenna shall not continue the Economic Development Program.</p> <p>"Shall the City of Ravenna continue a one-half percent (.5%) sales and use tax upon transactions within the City which are subject to the sales tax for a period of fifteen years, appropriating annually from local sources of revenue approximately \$85,000.00 per fiscal year during the time period of the City Sales and Use Tax which is provided for in this Proposition with 100% of the tax to be used for the Economic Development Program described in Proposition 1 above?"</p> <p><input type="radio"/> YES (for continuing the tax for Economic Development)</p> <p><input type="radio"/> NO (against continuing the tax for Economic Development)</p>
